

## WHAT WE DO

### + WE INSPIRE

At the heart of our sessions is inspirational support - motivating pupils to aspire higher and fulfil their potential. Mentors build a good rapport and close relationship with pupils through peer mentoring techniques, and demonstrate how academic success can change lives.

### + WE TUTOR

Given that raising aspirations in isolation will not be effective, our sessions include extra tuitions in the STEM subjects. The choice of specific modules within these subjects is flexible and is designed to be relevant to the child's specific needs.

### + WE GUIDE

Many pupils are unsuccessful because they do not know how to study. Our mentors help children improve their academic abilities, enabling them to study effectively and become active, independent learners.



## WHY WE ARE THE BEST

### IN-HOUSE MENTORING

The sessions are delivered on schools' premises. We have selected these locations as our venues because of costs, safety and logistics.

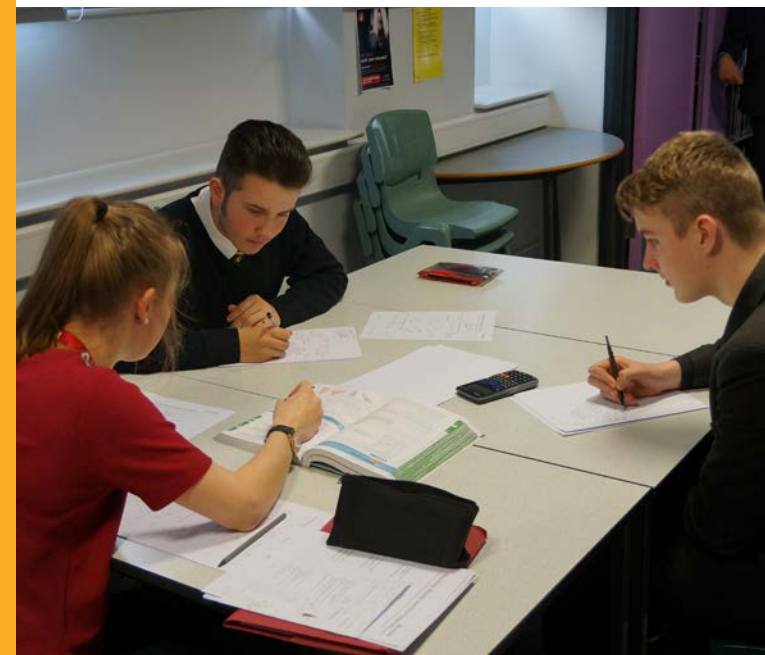

# OUR PACKAGES

Our standard schools mentoring package includes 15-hours of 1:1 or small group tuition. Sessions offer bespoke personalised learning in different academic subjects which are delivered on school premises on a flexible basis, for pupils in Year 6 to 11.



## HIGHER / FURTHER EDUCATION

We support educational growth, career exploration, and higher and further education.



## EXAM BOOSTER / RESIT

For pupils preparing for their exams, tutors provide revision services and teach exam techniques.



## STRUGGLING PUPILS

We support pupils who are struggling or identified as below age related expectation.



## STRONG PUPILS

Tuition for pupils who show the potential to fly high reaching a top-ranking university or competitive course.



## EAL PUPILS

# MENTOR'S MENTEE MATCHING

We have developed a consistent matching process to link schoolchildren to our mentors, to increase the likelihood of fostering a successful partnership. We consider these criteria:



## Schools' Preferences and Needs

Schools may express a preference for the potential mentors' gender, ethnicity, first or additional languages, interests, etc.



## Accessibility Issues and Location

This includes children with mobility needs and mentors who cannot travel to distant neighbourhoods or towns.



## Experience and Skills

We match academic achievements or the subject area of a mentor's studies that the school or child has expressed an interest in.



## Background

Whether mentors share similar ethnic backgrounds or experience with the child.



## Interests and Hobbies

Which mentors share similar interests with the child e.g. leisure activities, current affairs, music.
